6 **District/County Report.**

- a. Robin Millar emailed his County Council report which Liz Marchington read out to the meeting and is attached. Gloria Hicks noted there was no report on Broadband for Herringswell. RM to be asked.
- b. Carol Lynch advised the meeting that tomorrow FHDC will sign up to the devolution plan for the Eastern Region. Decision for Hatchfield Farm delayed again. Lance Stanbury also emailed his comments for the meeting on devolution and waste.

- a. Anglia Water have emailed their report. LM will email them requesting clarification on several points within their recent e-mail to the PC.
- b. Grass cutting. Alan Nunn is carrying out his complete cut of the Churchyard. As the 2 year plan is now at an end, we need to contact the Church to request a meeting before end August and to let them know we will involve the village, as

well as those out of the village, who have loved ones buried in the Churchyard. GH to prepare a leaflet.

- c. Condition of The Street. The pipes by the phone box appear to be blocked again making the road impassable by foot. SCC Guy Smith? needs to be contacted

- a) SIR consultation response. It was agreed that LM's prepared response on behalf of the PC be submitted with the addition of the comment on employment land.
- b) Manor Gym. This application is going before the Planning Committee on 6 July and has been recommended for refusal. Copy of the PC's reasons for refusal provided to CL

9 **Meetings:**

- a) LM attended LPWG meeting. RM mentioned there had been a call for sites by Cambridgeshire District Council resulting in a site for 1,000 dwelling coming forward for Kennett. This was later reduced to 500. This came up in a discussion on the transport assessment which FHDC have commissioned but would not be able to influence cross-border proposals.
- b) There is a Town & Parish forum on 13 July.
- c) Meeting has been arranged with RM on 17 July to discuss the farm road.
