22/07/5 i)	Planning Applications:West Suffolk Local Plan Preferred Options Consultation – May 2022The Parish Councillors discussed the consultation and looked at the documents that Cllr.Drummond provided;Resolved 22/07/5.01It was agreed to submit the following comments in relation to Herringswell;'Part 3 document – 3.6.6 Red Lodge constraints map on Page 137
	Herringswell Parish council are concerned that this map (shown below), again shows a settlement boundary around the small hamlet of Herringswell. This error was present in the previous round of consultation and drawn to the Councils attention through our submission. We were grateful to the council for accepting this error in their review of consultation responses (see link below), but are concerned that this has not been amended and remains present in the most recent round of consultations. We would ask that this is removed and perhaps the map rescaled so that Herringswell is not shown at all. We would also like to suggest that hamlets and small villages that do not make Type B villages and are rural/countryside, are listed in a separate category explaining this, within the Local Plan documents, thus confirming that no allocated sites have been allocated to those small villages/hamlets and are not therefore suitable for development.
