GH thanked the Parish Council for their continued support of the Village Hall. The hedges have been cut back and Alan Nunn is going to include regular outside maintenance in his village grass cutting. GH also expressed disappointment that very few residents support the Hall. GH has raised approx £1,000 from the sewing classes and hopes to continue with those on a regular monthly basis. The fire alarm and emergency lighting have been updated, the gents WCs have new flooring and it would appear that our long-standing, and costly, central heating issues may be now resolved. Annual accounts have not yet been prepared and there is approximately £1400 in the bank account.
